

Guidelines for Flock Assessments

These are held bi-annually in every Region in the Jacob Sheep Society. The purpose is to help experienced members to look in depth at the quality of their flocks and to give newer members some guidelines on how to improve their sheep.

All details of these Flock Assessments are available from your Regional Council member.

Two experienced judges will be appointed to visit the flocks taking part and will offer their comments and any advice that is requested.

A charge will be made for the visit (currently £15) and flock owners will receive a comment sheet after the visit.

Trophies are awarded for the Small and Large Flock Competitions. Only flocks with registered sheep are eligible for competition, but all members requiring advice are welcome to take part.
